(the remaining provisions are administered by the Attorney-General)

MINISTER FOR COMMUNITY SERVICES

Crimes (Mental Impairment and Unfitness to be Tried) Act 1997 .-

- Sections 45-55, 57A, 58, 60-63(1), 64- 73 and Part 7A are jointly administered with the Attorney-General and the Minister for Health
