What is Child Information Sharing?

Child Information Sharing allows certain professionals like teachers and nurses to share their experience and knowledge about a child with each other.

By sharing this information, professionals can paint a more complete picture of a child and better understand how they can support the child's wellbeing or safety.

Why is it important?

Children may need support at some stage in their lives. Child Information Sharing helps services provide this support by:

- Working together to help children and young people thrive
- Helping children receive the best support across services
- Seeing the full picture of children they work with

Information cannot be shared unless it's being used to promote the wellbeing or safety of children. There are strict rules around what can be shared and who can share that information.
