

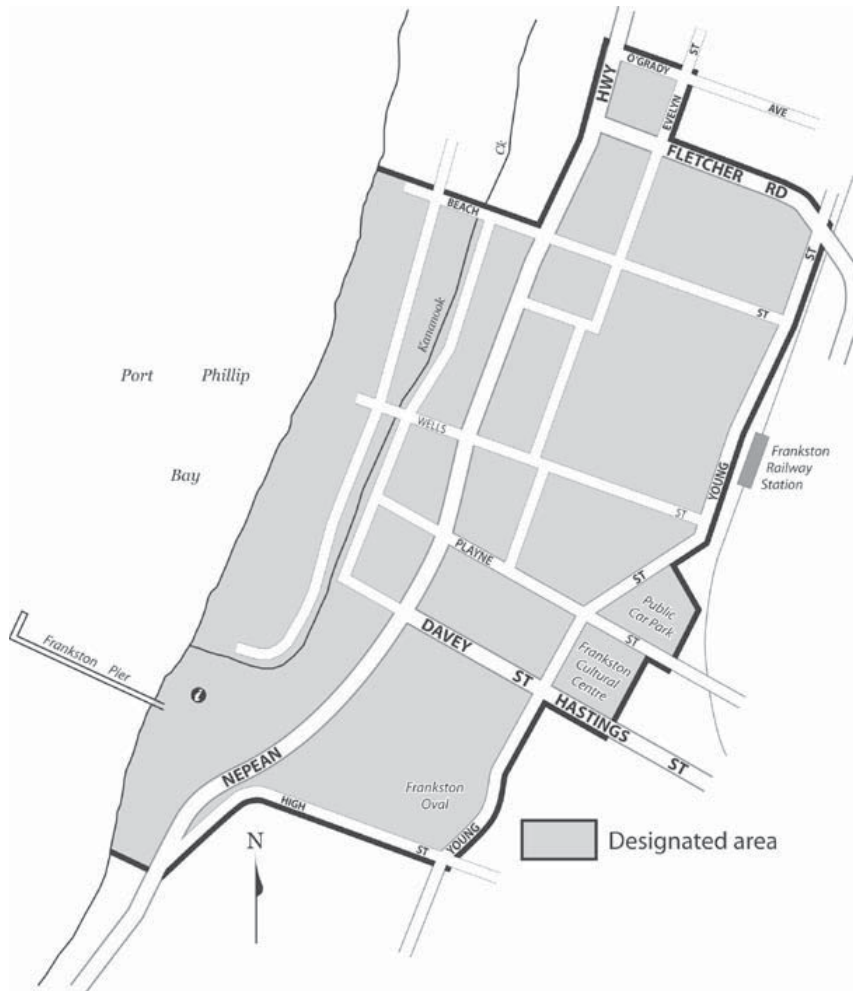
Liquor Control Reform Act 1998

SECTION 147 – ORDER DECLARING A DESIGNATED AREA

I, Susan Maclellan, Director of Liquor Licensing, pursuant to section 147 of the **Liquor Control Reform Act 1998** ('the Act'), declare the following area to be a designated area for the purposes of Part 8A of the Act:

Frankston

An area in the City of Frankston commencing at the low water mark of Port Phillip Bay in an easterly direction along the northern boundary of Beach Street to the western boundary of the intersection of the Nepean Highway then in a northerly direction to the intersection with the northern boundary of O'Grady Street then east to the western boundary intersection of Evelyn Street then southerly to the northern boundary of Fletcher Street then east to the intersection with the east boundary of Young Street then southerly to the east boundary of the public carpark then crossing Playne Street and following the east boundary of the Frankston Cultural Centre to the south boundary of Hastings Street then westerly to the east boundary of Young Street then southerly to the south boundary of High Street then west along High Street to the intersection with the Nepean Highway then in a westerly direction to the low water mark of Port Phillip Bay as shown on the following plan.



This order comes into operation on 5 March 2009.
