Packaged Liquor Licence Remote Checkout Authority

Liquor Control Reform Act 1998

Section 11(2) allows the Victorian Liquor Commission (the Commission) to authorise a packaged liquor licence to receive payment for liquor at any checkout. This is referred to as a 'remote checkout' and is subject to a number of restrictions:

- the licensed premises must be primarily used as a supermarket
- · the licensee must be the owner of the supermarket
- the person receiving the payment must be over the age of 18.
