Details of proposal

The Major Transport Infrastructure Authority requested advice on a proposal to pay the following executive above the maximum of the relevant remuneration band set by the Remuneration bands for executives employed in public service bodies (Victoria) Annual Adjustment Determination 2023.

Advice

- The Victorian Independent Remuneration Tribunal (Tribunal) advises the Major Transport Infrastructure Authority (MTIA) that an appropriate total remuneration package (TRP) for an executive in the position of Chief Executive Officer, Major Road Projects Victoria is \$645,000.
- 2 This TRP is considered to be appropriate for the following reasons:
 - (a) The functions and responsibilities of the position.
 - (b) The skills, knowledge and experience required for the position and how these would support the delivery of MTIA's organisational priorities and portfolio of road projects.
 - (c) The remuneration benchmarking information available to the Tribunal, including data on relevant comparators in the transport infrastructure market and the remuneration of comparable positions at the MTIA.
- The Tribunal notes that its advice must be sought again for a mid-contract remuneration adjustment, reappointment or a new appointment, if it is proposed to continue paying the executive above the maximum of the remuneration band.
