Clear expectations and commitments are important for supporting successful mentoring relationships and a productive mentoring program.

The WiT Mentoring Program is a 6-month commitment.

Mentees and mentors must agree to:

- meet at least once a month
- negotiate meeting locations and time commitments
- ensure that discussions remain confidential
- prepare for meetings and read the program resources provided
- participate in the professional development sessions
- access further support from the program coordinator when required
- keep their contact details up to date via the <u>Mentoring Platform</u>
- Notify the WiT Programs Team if your mentoring partner is disengaged.

It is strongly recommended that you:

- Attend the three main, in-person events
- Attend networking events with specific themes to boost your network and meet other mentors and mentees (many will be facing and negotiating the same challenges as you).
