

Murray-Darling carpet python



Who am I?

I am one of Victoria's two python species. I'm mostly silver with solid black blotches and stripes, but the colour of my scales can vary a lot. I can grow up to three-metres-long, or about as long as a car! I'm non-venomous but my bite can still be painful if I'm startled.

I live in rock crevices on the ground and up high in tree hollows, waiting for my meals to come to me. I like to eat rodents, frogs, lizards, and birds. Over winter, I can sleep for up to five months until the weather warms up again.

We breed every 3-4 years, and females will lay 20-50 eggs. I'm the only Victorian snake that guards its eggs, coiling around them to keep them warm until they hatch after 50-60 days. In Victoria, there's sadly only about 160 of us left in the wild, so every new hatchling counts! **Scientific name** Morelia spilota metcalfei

Carpet pythons are also bred for people to keep as pets with a wildlife licence, but they are different to the ones you might see in the wild.

How can you help me?

If I happen to slither past you in the wild, you can look but don't touch me! It's safer for both of us when you leave me alone.


It's not okay to take me or any other wildlife home from the wild. So, if you're thinking of getting a pet python, you'll need to get it from a licenced source, and have the right licence. And remember, you can never release your pet python into the wild as they could spread diseases to wild snakes!
