Do you have <u>a members and guest register</u> and are they displayed in a prominent location?		
Do you have an <u>incident register</u> ?		
Do you have an <u>event management plan</u> ? This might assist you considering risks and preparing for the finals day.		
Are you planning on running a second point of sale or varying your hours? If yes, have you applied for a <u>temporary limited licence</u> ?		

Remember to talk to your volunteers and members about:

The conditions on your liquor licence to ensure everyone understands them (for example trading hours).

The responsible service of alcohol and have a plan in place to manage intoxicated or drunk customers.

The availability of free drinking water at all times.

The laws relating to minors and when they can and can't be at your club.

Any house policies that your club has developed.
